Partnership & Collaboration

 The EV Strike Force created a public/private partnership in collaboration with Policy Makers, Private Sector Stakeholders, Environmental NGOs, and Equity Groups

 As a partnership we jointly adopted Terms of Reference for a 2-year joint effort. And we completed our mission in 2 years within budget!

Established Targets

 The EV Strike Force established agreed-upon targets for the advancement of equitable, accessible, and affordable EV charging infrastructure in conjunction with the CEC's 2127 report and private sector assessments

Largest Investment in Infrastructure Ever

- The EV Strike Force organized and expanded a diverse coalition in support of California's state investment in charging infrastructure
- Originally intended to secure reauthorization of AB8, this diverse group of stakeholders helped secure the largest ever and first ever funding for ZEVs and infrastructure over 5 years

Completed Reports

Completed a Jobs Assessment with a focus on equitable jobs transition
This is foundational work that helped inform the equity discussion and outline
potential metrics for equitable jobs opportunities as the state transitions to a fully
electric on-road fleet

Completed an Equity Resource Document

The Equity Workgroup came together to better define the meaning of equity in the context of EV charging infrastructure and established recommended metrics for entities to track progress towards an equitable transitions to ZEVs and charging infrastructure
